Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage (ABN)

NOTE: If Medicare doesn't pay for your HIV test below, you may have to pay.

Medicare does not pay for everything, even some care that you or your health care provider have good reason to think you need. We expect Medicare may not pay for the HIV test below.

Laboratory test(s)	Reason Medicare May Not Pay:	Estimated Cost
Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) test	Medicare pays for screening HIV test only once per 12 months; but will pay for up to 3 screening HIVs for pregnancy. If Medicare's coverage limits have not been exceeded, you will not receive a bill from ALI.	\$68.00

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW:

- Read this notice, so you can make an informed decision about your care.
- Ask us any questions that you may have after you finish reading.
- Choose an option below about whether to receive the HIV test listed above.

Note: If you choose Option 1 or 2, we may help you to use any other insurance that you might have, but Medicare cannot require us to do this.

OPTIONS: Check only one box. We cannot choose a box for you.

OPTION 1. I want the HIV test listed above. You may ask to be paid now, but I also want Medicare billed for an official decision on payment, which is sent to me on a Medicare Summary Notice (MSN). I understand that if Medicare doesn't pay, I am responsible for payment, but **I can appeal to Medicare** by following the directions on the MSN. If Medicare does pay, you will refund any payments I made to you, less co-pays or deductibles.

OPTION 2. I want the HIV test listed above, but do not bill Medicare. You may ask to be paid now as I am responsible for payment. **I cannot appeal if Medicare is not billed.**

OPTION 3. I don't want the HIV test listed above. I understand with this choice I am **not** responsible for payment, and **I cannot appeal to see if Medicare would pay.**
